It gives me great pleasure to report that the following De Gruyter title has been selected for inclusion in *Choice*'s annual **OAT** list, which will appear in the January 2012 issue of *Choice* Magazine:

Handbook of medieval studies: terms-methods-trends, ed. by Albrecht Classen.

This year's **Outstanding Academic Title** list includes 629 books and electronic resources chosen by the *Choice* editorial staff from among the 7,263 titles reviewed by *Choice* during the past year. Of these, 600 are print products; the remaining 29 are electronic.
